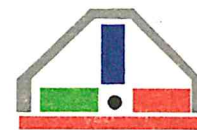

TELPOSTA PENSION SCHEME AND PROVIDENT FUND
OPERATIONS IN THE WAKE OF THE 3rd WAVE OF CORONA VIRUS PANDEMIC

As you may be aware, The President of the Republic of Kenya, H.E Uhuru Kenyatta, in his address to the Nation on 12th March 2021, announced an increasing number of Corona Virus infections as well as deaths (3rd Wave of infections) and issued directions aimed at curbing the spread of the virus. These measures have and will continue impacting on TelPosta Pension Scheme & Provident Fund operations and its annual calendar of activities.

We confirm as follows;

1. Visits to Scheme/Fund Offices

We sincerely thank all members who have refrained from physically visiting Scheme/Fund offices as a measure to contain the spread of Covid-19 pandemic.

However, we note that some members including those from far flunk areas have been visiting the offices to inquire on matters that can easily be addressed via other available communication channels. We appeal to members to avoid unnecessary travel and visits to Scheme/Fund offices and make use of the communication channels outlined below.

3. Life Certificates for the Year 2021

Life Certificates for the year 2021 for Pensioners and Dependants in receipt of a monthly pension were dispatched on 18th February 2021 to the respective last known Postal Addresses. Pensioners and Dependants are requested to refrain from dropping their filled Life Certificates to the office but instead either send them to us via our post office address or scan and send via email.

4. Annual General Meeting 2021

The Scheme/Fund was planning to have the **usual physical** Annual General Meetings (AGM) in the Eight (8) stations. However, pursuant to the Government directives that limit the number of people at gatherings due to the surge in Covid-19 infections and given the age profile of our membership, the Trustees will hold a Virtual AGM to be televised live and to be held before 15th June 2021. More details on the AGM shall be communicated later.

5. Election of Member Nominated Trustee

The Term of one (1) Trustee, **Mr. John Peter Mdhune Onginjo** was to expire after 2020 May AGM and consequently there was to arise one (1) vacancy for election of Member Nominated Trustee during 2020 AGM to fill one (1) Trustee slot.

However, since the 2020 AGM was not held, Mr. John Peter Mdhune Onginjo has continued to serve as a Trustee.

The Scheme/Fund is now planning to hold the election of one (1) member nominated Trustee which shall be carried out through a mobile phone voting system to be held before 15th June 2021. All members shall be able to vote from any location. More details on the Election of one (1) member nominated Trustee shall be communicated later.

6. Payment of Benefits to eligible members

As at the moment, the Scheme/Fund will continue to process and make prompt pension benefits payments as and when they fall due to eligible members and beneficiaries in accordance with the prevailing Retirement Benefits Act, Retirement Benefits Regulations and the Trust Deed & Rules of the Scheme/Fund.

The Scheme/Fund Board of Trustees is committed to following ALL Government Legislation and Guidelines and be in constant communication with all stakeholders.

We encourage you to limit travel and stay at home to safeguard your health and well-being. Let us help the Government to fight the spread of Covid-19.
